Earthquakes Hit Gulf of California

A pair of earthquakes, with magnitudes of 6.9 and 6.2, struck Mexico's Gulf of California early Thursday, April 12. The quakes, both with shallow epicenters just over 6 miles underground, were centered about 85 miles northeast of Guerrero Negro in the Mexican state and 325 miles south-southwest of Phoenix in the United States. The tremblers triggered no tsunami warnings; and no immediate damages were reported either.
