

Carlotta Weakens after Ravaging Southern Mexico

Carlotta had slammed southern Mexico as of Friday the 15 of June (GMT). The hurricane then waned to a tropical depression over the mountains during the weekend.

Carlotta with the strength of a hurricane drenched Oaxaca State and brought down a house; so far two deaths have been reported. As of Saturday the 16th, the tropical depression was located about 50 miles north-northeast of Acapulco and moving toward the northwest at about 12 mph. The storm was expected to affect the area for days while warnings and watches were discontinued.
