

## Recovery Begins in Oklahoma after the Strike

Three days after the strike of a deadly tornado, recovery began as rescue came to an end.

According to the National Weather Service, the tornado had gusts over 200 mph at times as it pummeled thousands of houses in the affected region and thus was recorded in the category of the strongest storm. The violent twister tore through central Oklahoma, causing critical devastation to Moore City. The tornado killed at least 24 people, including 10 children, and injured over 350 people.
