

Devastating Tornadoes Struck the States

In early June, several devastating tornadoes and storms struck the central and western regions of Massachusetts State, affecting 19 local communities and taking more than 4 lives.

Back in late May, a major tornado hit Joplin City, Missouri State, causing a casualty more than 130; still in April, Alabama State also went under the destructive occurrence of a tornado.

According to the United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS), the hurricane season is just around the corner; meanwhile, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) also confirmed the remaining of the hurricane season until the end of November.
